

EUROPEAN BRANCH 2016 TRAINING COURSE PROGRAMME January 2016

Welcome to our new 2016 Training Programme, which builds solidly on the successes that we have achieved over the previous five years.

We once more go 'back to our roots' by offering four Introductory Courses in International Arbitration, which will be held in Riga on 25 February, Paris on 12 March, Prague on 18 March and in Warsaw also on 18 March.

Once we have a better understanding of how many participants we will have in each location, we will follow up these Introductory Courses with our Module 1 and Module 2 Courses in these locations that lead on to Full membership of the CI Arb.

In addition, our first **Module 2** (Laws of Arbitration) Course of the year starts in Istanbul on 19 February, and our **Module 3** Course has just started in Istanbul.

Our challenging **Module 4** (Award Writing) Course has just started in Athens.

Our ever-popular **Accelerated Route to Membership** (ARM) Courses are intended for those with some experience and knowledge of the international arbitration process. Our ARM participants have the opportunity over two days to demonstrate their knowledge and experience and gain Full Membership of the CI Arb. This year we are holding our ARM Course in Paris on **9 and 10 April 2016**.

We are delighted to confirm the return of our **Accelerated Route to Fellowship** (ARF) Course for 2016, which this year will be held in Madrid on 3 to 5 June 2016. This Course is open to members and non-members of the CI Arb that are experienced in International Arbitration and who now wish to become Fellows of the CI Arb.

Our **Mediation Courses** are also being addressed, and further information will be made available once details are finalised.
